The **City of Belton** (Owner) is requesting Bids for the **Big O’Neal Sewer Subbasin Rehabilitation Phase 2 (Division A)** project which includes furnishing all materials, equipment, and labor necessary construct the following summary of Work and approximate quantities:

Pipe bursting of 2,226 Linear Feet (LF) of 8” HDPE, 293 LF of 10” HDPE, and 366 LF of 12” HDPE sewer lines. Open cut replacement of 22 LF of 10” DIP sewer lines. Reconnection of 34 lateral connections, Structural manhole rehabilitation of 5 manholes totaling 20 vertical feet of lining, miscellaneous point repairs, pavement repair and all restoration. The bid is divided into a Base Bid with three (3) add alternates.

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **City of Belton** located at **306 Anderson Street, Belton, SC 29627, until June 3, 2025, at 10:00 AM** local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

Prospective contractors shall follow the Davis-Bacon and Related Acts that requires all laborers and mechanics employed by contractors and subcontractors be paid wages at rates not less than those listed on the prevailing wage rate contained in the contract documents and that all applicable provisions of the Davis-Bacon and Related Acts be met.

Bidders must comply with all applicable state and federal requirements identified in the bid documents regarding “American Iron and Steel” provisions of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014 (Section 426)
